## Geographically-Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA) Number of barangays per region in the Philippines as of April 30, 2019



Health services serve patients, families, communities, and populations and cover emergency, preventative, rehabilitative, long-term, hospital, diagnostic, primary, palliative, and home care. The health services mentioned are centered around making health care accessible, high quality, and patient-centered. The rest of the mentioned healthy determinants interrelate to GIDAS as an equally challenging factor to address health for all.



## UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE ACT

Filipino citizens, including Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs), can now be enrolled in the National Health Insurance Program. The law also mandates the expansion of PhilHealth coverage to include **free medical consultations and laboratory tests**. This is an access to quality and affordable healthcare services for all Filipinos.

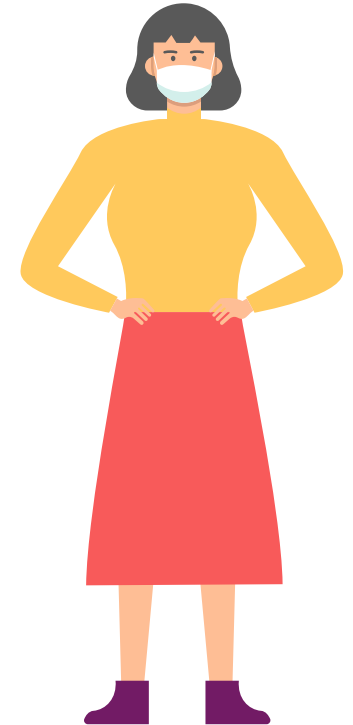
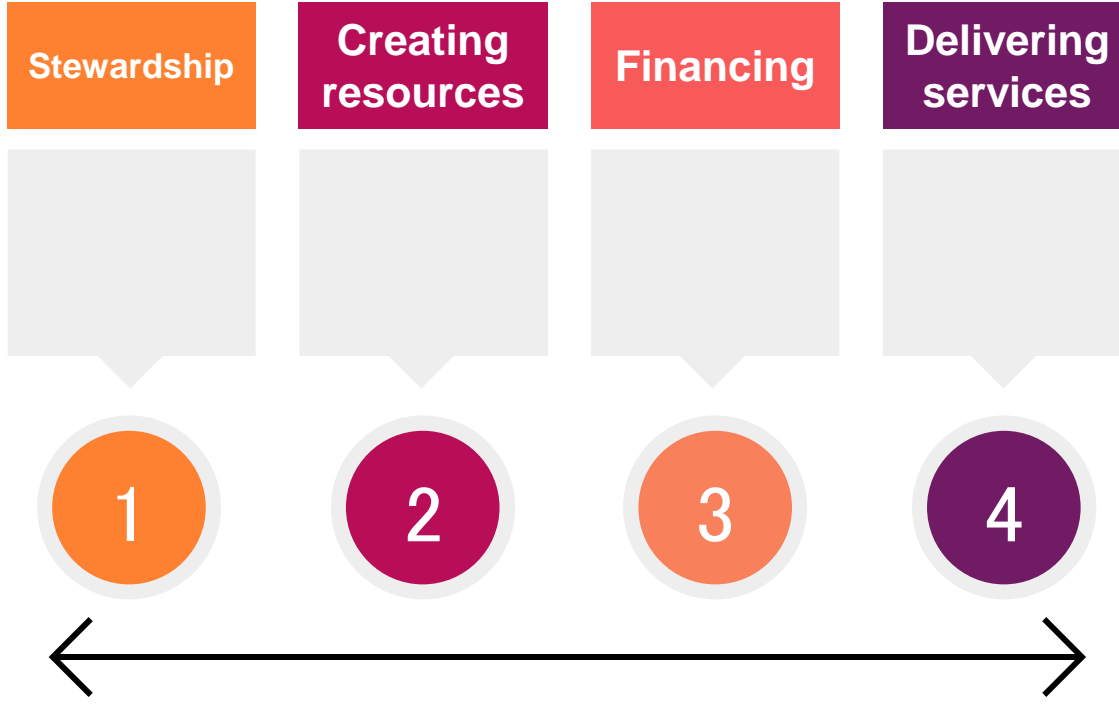
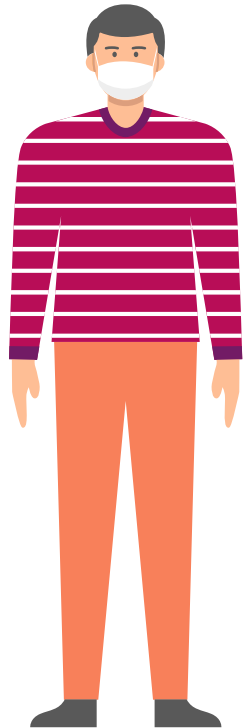
